**10% Class-test 1 + 10 % Class-test 2+ 10% Class-test 3+ 5% Activity 1+ 5% Activity 2+ 10%HHW+ 50% SA I.**

I request all the parents to ensure stress-free environment at home. I would like to share that

- 1) the school owes the responsibility of preparing the students for learning and revision is in progress smoothly.
- 2) the format of the tests or the blueprint have already been discussed in the class.
- 3) tests are objective as well subjective and to be done partially in QP and rest in A/B provided.
- 4) the objective of the assessment is to test learning and not learner.
- 5) even the final revision for the next assessment will be done in the school after the test post lunch.
- 6) the process has been designed to give an experience of sitting for two and half hour's time, observe the 15 min. cool off time etc.
- 7) this one shot test is not the ultimate assessment. It is a portion of continuous and comprehensive evaluation.

I look forward to your cooperation and collaboration. Enjoy the experience of active and self -learning by your child.
